Sarah and ask Elmara to order one.

When will we get watermelon again? It's back in the veg shop and on the menu in school (only available in the summer months).

Can we have ice lollies for desert at lunchtime in the hall?

No – we sometimes buy lollies on VERY hot days or for a special treat. Can we have fruit juice at lunchtime rather than water or milk?

No – it contains a lot of sugar and would be too expensive to buy for 300 children!

We need more bug hotels and gardening in the playgrounds.

Great idea – maybe the new Eco Team could organise this in September, with Laura.

Can we have coat hooks in the KS2 playground?

If you get warm, coats can be put on the seating area by the table tennis tables. No room for lots of pegs as the walls are used by children playing thumb ball.

Can the jerk chicken be less spicy?

Yes – Elmara will ask Ali to adjust the recipe so that everyone can enjoy it. The Astroturf in the KS2 playground is very old and needs replacing, so it's soft again.

We do regular safety checks and will have to wait until we have the funds to replace it, as it's an expensive job. When is the end girls' downstairs, toilet going to be repaired?

Yes – we'd love to organise the tournament again as we know how popular it is. We're planning it for the return to school in September when it's less busy with events and trips.

Can we go on more trips please?

Yes – lots of exciting trips will be planned for the new school year.
