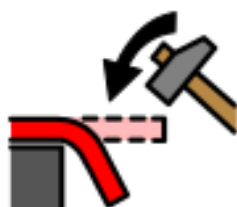



sculpture	The art of forming solid objects that represent a thing, person or idea. Sculptures can be made from materials such as wood, clay, metal, and stone.		<div>Clay Sculpture Techniques</div> <div>I think gentle and slow, when I am working with moist clay.
